We wish Jacelyn Hemmelgarn the best in her future endeavors, and the Board of Directors hopes to fill the vacant position early in the coming year.

Our finances are diversified, and we are maintaining sufficient funds to ensure that we remain solvent while investing and returning more to our members than ever before. Our meetings have successfully survived the COVID shutdown and our departure from FASS. We are expanding member services and seeking to expand our reach and impact globally.



As of December 13, 2022, the Association had <u>**1,621 members**</u>.

In 2022, Sam Shafer and I connected with peer reviewers via a broad email campaign. All reviewers listed in the PSA database were contacted and asked to confirm their reviewer status for PSA's journals. More than 1,100 reviewers between both *Poultry Science®* and *The Journal of Applied Poultry Research* responded that they would like to continue serving in that capacity, while fewer than 300 respondents between both journals declined to continue reviewing manuscripts. The importance of reliable and thorough peer-reviewers cannot be overstated, and I want to express my genuine gratitude for those who have served and continue to serve their scientific community.

Also in 2022, Dr. Michael H. Kogut was named Editor-in-Chief of Poultry Science, taking the helm from his predecessor, Dr. Robert L. Taylor, Jr., who had served as EIC since 2016. Dr. Kogut had previously served as one of the journal's most dedicated and dependable Section Editors in the Immunology, Health, and Disease section. I'd like to extend my sincerest thanks to Dr. Taylor for his years of unwavering service to the journal, and my warmest welcome to Dr. Kogut as the newest deserving captain of PSA's flagship.



With the COVID-19 Pandemic changing the way our Annual Meeting took place in 2020 and 2021, we were ecstatic to finally reconvene in-person in San Antonio for the 2022 PSA Annual Meeting. This conference was the first time the PSA staff handled all of the logistics and meeting planning without the assistance of FASS. From a communications standpoint, this involved digital marketing through email and social media and print production for signage and the program. The staff is extremely pleased with how this meeting went and we received a multitude of compliments from attendees and members alike.

The Association's online presence continues to grow. This year, we started an Instagram account and garnered attention to it through our Meme Contest. Instagram continues to grow and exhibits popularity internationally. The Hatchery's social accounts on Facebook and LinkedIn have been transitioned from private groups to public-facing pages. This transition allows for greater exposure to prospective student members. The Hatchery has a goal to continue promoting and growing these pages into 2023 and beyond. PSA's overall social media presence serves to relay information, events, and the latest science that would be of interest and relevance to all those in the poultry science community. Our social media channels help work towards the mission and vision of the Association.

As we enter 2023, the Association will research opportunities in technology and consider new outlets to disseminate the science from our journals. We are also working to enhance our in-person marketing at events such as the International Production and Processing Expo and our Annual Meeting.

Annual Meeting

The Poultry Science Association was thrilled to return to an in-person format for the 2022 PSA Annual Meeting! There were over 980 people from 37 different countries in attendance at the July 2022 conference held in San Antonio, Texas. The conference featured more than 480 abstracts, 7 symposia, the WPSA Lecture, and 2 workshops. During the week, attendees also enjoyed PSA's signature networking events like the PSA BBO and Student Mixer!

The Annual Meeting's Student Competition resumed its pre-pandemic structure as well. Abstracts were presented live and in-person, allowing presenters to test their ability to answer questions about their research and confidently speak to audiences. Competition winners were announced during the Thursday evening Awards Celebration, allowing students and professionals alike to celebrate the winners of not only the competition but other prestigious awards.

Time and again event participants commented on how wonderful it was to be back together in-person where they were able to network with industry peers, celebrate the accomplishments of friends and students, and take in the newest developments in the poultry industry. PSA sees the value of the in-person PSA Annual Meeting and plans to continue executing it in this fashion going forward.

PSA's staff and board goals for the 2023 PSA Annual Meeting are to continue growing the attendance numbers, eventually surpassing the 2019 in-person total of 1,400 people. Staff has also set their focus on improving the exhibitor aspect of the conference. Although there has been a decline in exhibitor participation in the last decade, PSA sees the value of the expo to both the attendees and the organizations participating. With this in mind, staff is already working on growing the number of exhibitors for the 2023 PSA Annual Meeting in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania.


