Application Checklist

When applying for this scholarship, be sure to have all the following information and documents prepared for the submission form.

Applicant Information*

- Name, Institution, and Email
- Checkboxes to Confirm:
 - That you hold sophomore or junior status based on credits.
 - That you hold an active student membership with the Poultry Science Association.
 - That you are studying at an institution based in the United States.
 - That you agree to participate in a Zoom video interview if requested by the selection committee.

Resume & Transcripts*

- Overall GPA (to be typed in)
- Unofficial Transcripts (to be uploaded)
- Resume/CV (to be uploaded)

Letters of Support & Essay*

Letters should indicate how the writer knows the candidate and outlines the writer's involvement in the Poultry Industry.

- Letter of Support #1 (to be uploaded)
- Letter of Support #2 (to be uploaded)
- Essay (to be uploaded) on **one** of the following topics:
 - Why a career in poultry is for me and my personal experience with poultry.
 - Poultry as a research animal: past, present, and future.
 - Poultry as a food animal: past, present, and future.

Optional Personal Statement (Maximum of 300 words or 1-2 Minute Video)

This gives you the opportunity to introduce yourself, your background, interests, and goals to the selection committee. This also leaves more room in your essay to talk about poultry and the selected topic. You may upload this in a written format or submit a hyperlink to the video online.

The personal statement is NOT required.

- Video Link (suggested as a YouTube link) **OR**
- Written Document (not exceeding 500 words)
