2023 PSA Annual Meeting

Below are guidelines established by the PSA Board of Directors for publishing symposium papers for the 2023 PSA Annual Meeting. It is expected that all symposia will publish papers in one of the PSA journals.

2023 Poultry Science Association Annual Meeting Symposium Paper Criteria

DEADLINE FOR PAPER SUBMISSION: JULY 1, 2023

Poultry Science Symposium Proceedings

Two different approaches are available and can be decided upon by the symposium chair. At the time the initial proposal is submitted in October, the proposal must include the intended journal for publication and the intended format for the proceedings. All speakers in a symposium must use the same publishing format and journal.

Papers are submitted by the symposium chair to the **Annual Meeting Program Committee Chair**.

Approach #1:

Submit a single proceedings paper that is a composite paper of all topics covered during the symposium.

- a. All speakers are listed as authors on the paper.
- b. An overall summary and conclusion tying the topics together and relevancy to the journal audience must be included.
- c. Each speaker provides a 2-3 page extended abstract on the topic discussed. These topics will be section headings and the speaker listed as the author of the section.
- d. Figures/graphs/tables are encouraged to easily convey data from the speakers.
- e. Any preliminary/unpublished data included in the written document must be identified clearly for the audience.
- f. Citations are important but not absolute.

Approach #2:

Proceedings papers can be published by each individual presenter on the topics covered within the symposium (series of stand-alone papers).

- a. The symposium chair is responsible for submitting all papers at the same time to the **Annual Meeting Program Committee Chair** by the submission deadline.
- b. These individuals' proceedings papers would follow formatting:
 - i. *The Journal of Applied Poultry Research* (reviews, research reports or field reports)
 - ii. *Poultry Science* (reviews)

Poultry Science Submission Guidelines

All manuscript style and form guidelines of the journal shall be followed. These submissions will be subject to peer review and may be accepted or rejected in the same manner as other submissions.

The Journal of Applied Poultry Research Submission Guidelines

The format may be similar to reviews, research reports, or field reports, as outlined in the Style and Form. These submissions will be subject to peer review and may be accepted or rejected in the same manner as other submissions.
